McLeodganj



Dharamshala Cricket Stadium

Perched at an elevation of 1,457 metres in the scenic Kangra Valley amidst the majestic Dhauladhar mountain range. This is one of the highest cricket stadiums in the world. Managed by the HPCA, the Cricket Stadium regularly serves as a practice venue for the Indian Cricket Team, the Himachal Pradesh state cricket team, and Indian Premier League franchises. Renowned for its breathtaking setting, often compared to the Adelaide Oval and Newlands, the stadium also welcomes tourists even when no matches are being played.

Distance from hotel 13.8 km | 38 minutes



Gyuto Monastery



Popularly known for its teachings in Tantric meditation and philosophy, the Gyuto Monastery is one of the most renowned and picturesque monasteries in Dharamshala. Founded in India in 1959, it was established to preserve and promote the Tantric traditions of the great teacher Tsongkhapa. The monastery showcases how these ancient teachings, often misunderstood, are rooted in spiritual practice and are intended to promote wisdom, compassion, and the well-being of humanity.

Distance from hotel 18.3 km | 51 minutes



Bhagsu Naag Temple

Surrounded by serene pools and lush greenery, the Bhagsunag Temple is one of the oldest and most revered temples, located about 3 km from McLeodganj. Also known as the Bhagsunath Temple, it holds great religious significance for the local Gorkha and Hindu communities. The two sacred pools adjacent to the temple are believed to possess healing properties and are revered for their miraculous powers.

Distance from hotel 1.1 km | 6 minutes



Dal Lake



Named after the iconic Dal Lake of Srinagar, this tranquil lake is surrounded by rugged mountains and majestic deodar trees. Its peaceful ambience makes it a favourite among nature lovers, who can observe a variety of fish in their natural habitat. Fringed by lush greenery and vibrant trees, the lake offers a perfect setting to relax with family and friends amidst nature. For those seeking adventure, trekking trails around the lake provide an exciting way to explore its scenic surroundings.

Distance from hotel 4.1 km | 15 minutes



Dalai Lama Temple

Steeped in Tibetan culture, the Dalai Lama Temple, also known as the Tsuglakhang Temple, is an important politico-religious centre in Dharamshala. Renowned for its serene atmosphere, the temple offers an ideal setting for meditation and spiritual reflection, with monks chanting prayers throughout the day using prayer wheels and beads. Located close to the residence of His Holiness the Dalai Lama, the temple is frequently visited by him for teachings and prayer gatherings. Surrounded by a picturesque setting, the temple complex has become one of the most revered pilgrimage sites for Buddhists from around the world.

Distance from hotel 1.6 km | 9 minutes



The Tibet Museum

Located in the suburban town of McLeodganj, Dharamshala, the Tibet Museum is one of the region's most prominent cultural attractions. Serving as the official museum of the Central Tibetan Administration's Department of Information and International Relations, it is situated close to the Dalai Lama Temple, also known as the Tsuglagkhang Complex, the residence of His Holiness the Dalai Lama. Showcasing exceptional Tibetan craftsmanship, the museum houses a remarkable collection of historical documents, pottery, traditional handicrafts, artworks, and exhibits that offer a deep insight into Tibetan history and culture.

Distance from hotel 3.4 km | 17 minutes



Bhagsu Falls



The Bhagsu Waterfall is one of the most popular tourist attractions in Dharamshala, drawing visitors who seek to immerse themselves in nature and enjoy moments of peace and tranquillity. Located along the main road connecting McLeodganj and Dharamshala, the waterfall is an ideal spot for picnics with family and friends. Adding to its charm is the nearby Bhagsunath Temple, a revered shrine and one of the area's famous attractions

Distance from hotel 1.6 km | 8 minutes



Dharamshala To McLeodganj Ropeway

The Dharamshala Skyway is a 1.8 km-long ropeway connecting Dharamshala and McLeodganj, covering the journey in just five minutes. Featuring a modern monocable detachable gondola system with 18 gondolas, two stations, and ten towers, the upper station is conveniently located opposite the Dalai Lama Temple. The ropeway offers breathtaking aerial views of the town, the majestic mountains, and the surrounding lush greenery, making it a memorable experience for visitors and an excellent opportunity to capture stunning photographs.



Trekking To Triund



Triund is one of the most popular and easy treks in Himachal Pradesh, offering a refreshing escape into the majestic Himalayas. Located a few kilometres from Dharamshala at an altitude of 2,828 metres, it is an ideal destination for trekking enthusiasts, with scenic trails that provide breathtaking views of the entire Kangra Valley. The trek to Triund is short and relatively easy, beginning either from McLeodganj or Dharamkot, which lies about 2 km beyond McLeodganj. The spectacular sunset and starlit skies from Triund make it a perfect spot for overnight camping and an unforgettable mountain experience.



Paragliding



Blessed with an abundance of scenic hills, Dharamshala has become a popular destination for paragliding in Himachal Pradesh. Offering an exhilarating experience, the sport allows adventure enthusiasts to soar like birds above the majestic mountain ranges and lush tea gardens under clear blue skies. Indrunag and Bir Billing are among the most sought-after paragliding destinations near Dharamshala, attracting thrill-seekers from across the country.
