Jaisalmer Fort

Tanot Mata Temple



Tanot Mata Temple is a sacred destination where faith, history, and patriotism come together. Dedicated to Goddess Tanot Rai, the temple is renowned for the remarkable events of the Indo-Pak wars of 1965 and 1971, when several bombs dropped nearby reportedly remained unexploded. These preserved shells continue to symbolise unwavering faith and courage. Maintained by the Border Security Force (BSF), the temple offers a peaceful and spiritual atmosphere, making it a meaningful stop for pilgrims, history lovers, and travellers alike.
